In the spirit of reconciliation, we acknowledge with respect, the history and living culture of the Anishinaabek: The People of the Three Fires known as Ojibway, Odawa, and Pottawatomi Nation, who have inhabited this land from time immemorial. We recognize that these lands are the territories of the Chippewas of Saugeen and the Chippewas of Nawash, collectively known as the Saugeen Ojibway Nation, the keepers of this land.

 - 6.3.1 DEV2025-073 Severance Application B14/25 Elizabeth Van Loo and the Estate of Cornelius Van Loo

Recommendation:

It has been demonstrated that the proposed application B14/25 is consistent with the Provincial Planning Statement 2024 and complies with the Grey County Official Plan and the general intent and purpose of the Township of Georgian Bluffs Zoning By-law 2020-020.

Accordingly, it is recommended that the application be approved with the following conditions applied:

- That a Reference Plan be completed, and a copy filed with the Municipal Clerk or an exemption from the Reference Plan be received from the Land Registry Office.
- 2. That, pursuant to Section 53(42) of the Planning Act, the 'Certificate of Consent' be affixed to the deed within two years of the giving of the Notice of Decision. Note: Section 53(43) of the Planning Act requires that the transaction approved by this consent must be carried out within two years of the issuance of the certificate (i.e., stamping of the deed).
- 3. That the applicant pays the applicable consent

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- certification fee at the time of certification of the deeds.
- 4. That a supporting Zoning By-law Amendment be in force and effect to re-zone the lands to a site-specific zone under the AG Zone to prohibit the future construction of a new residential dwelling of any type on the retained lands as well as to reduce the minimum lot area requirement of an agricultural lot in the 'AG' zone, as it applies to the retained parcel, from 40 hectares 39.6 hectares, and, reduce the 'minimum lot area' requirement of a residential lot in the 'AG' zone, as it applies to the severed parcel, from 40 hectares to 1.2 hectares, and, increase the maximum lot coverage of the 'AG' zone, as it applies to the severed parcel, from 1% to 10% for the accessory buildings and from 10% to 14% for all buildings.
- 5. That approval and/or entrance permits be obtained from the Grey County Transportation Department for the entrances to the retained parcel from Grey Bruce Line, and that the proposed field entrance be located 100 metres from the existing entrance for the severed lot.
- 6. That the owner obtains a Section 65 Report for the proposed severance.

Recommendation:

It has been demonstrated that applications B13/25 and A07/25 for Elizabeth Van Loo and the Estate of Cornelius Van Loo for lands described as CON B PT LOT 9, is consistent with the Provincial Planning Statement 2024, conforms to the County of Grey's Official Plan, and complies with the intent of the Township of Georgian Bluffs' Zoning By-law 2020-020. It is recommended that the applications be approved subject to the following conditions:

- That a Reference Plan be completed, and a copy filed with the Municipal Clerk or an exemption from the Reference Plan be received from the Land Registry Office. The Reference Plan should conform substantially to the sketch (Schedule 'A') filed with the Application for Consent.
- 2. That, pursuant to Section 53(42) of the Planning Act, the 'Certificate of Consent' be affixed to the deed within two years of the giving of the Notice of Decision. Note: Section 53(43) of the Planning Act requires that the transaction approved by this consent must be carried out within two years of the issuance of the certificate (i.e. stamping of the deed).
- 3. That the applicant pays the applicable consent certification fee at the time of certification of the deeds.
- 4. That the payment of the balance of any outstanding taxes, as of the date of the certification of the Transfer/Deed with respect to the property that is subject to the application shall be made to the Treasurer of the Township of Georgian Bluffs.

Recommendation:

It has been demonstrated that the proposed application B19-25 is consistent with the Provincial Planning Statement 2024, complies with the Grey County Official Plan, is consistent with the Township of Georgian Bluffs Official Plan, and aligns with the general intent and purpose of the Township of Georgian Bluffs Zoning By-law 2020-020. Accordingly, it is recommended that application B19/25 be approved with the following conditions applied:

- That a Reference Plan be completed, and a copy filed with the Municipal Clerk or an exemption from the Reference Plan be received from the Land Registry Office.

6.1 New Applications

6.1.1 DEV2025-067 - Consent Application B15/25 Breen and the Bruce Trail Conservancy

The Secretary-Treasurer indicated that there have been no request(s) for deferral or withdrawal of the application. Notice of the Severance, in accordance with Ontario Regulation 197/96, made under the Planning Act, was given on August 22, 2025, by ordinary mail to all property owners within 60 metres of the property which is subject to the application and to all the required agencies. Notice was also posted on the Subject Lands and the Township's website. If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Committee of Adjustment, you must make a written request to the Secretary Treasurer of the Committee. Only a person or public body that requests a notice of decision of the Committee in respect to this proposed Severance may submit an appeal.

Joel Swaggerman from the Bruce Trail Conservancy registered with the Secretary-Treasurer to provide comment on behalf of the applicant.

No public was in attendance.

The Committee expressed concern that a "conservation easement" should also be placed on the severed lands to ensure that no future

development takes place, and the following motion was put forward.

The subject property is located on the eastern side of Grey-Bruce Line, between Grey Road 16 and Concession 6 Arran, within the Township of Georgian Bluffs. According to Schedule 'A' – Official Plan Policy Areas of the Township of Georgian Bluffs Official Plan, the property is identified as "Lands Subject to the Grey County Official Plan." Within the County of Grey Official Plan, the property is designated as "Agricultural" and "Hazard Lands" on Schedule A. The property is zoned "Agricultural" and "Environmental Protection" under the Township of Georgian Bluffs Zoning By-law 2020-020.

The purpose of Application B14/25 is to sever approximately 1.24-hectare of land containing a dwelling and accessory structures from a 40.91-hectare agricultural property as a surplus farm dwelling severance. 39.67-hectares will be retained for continued agricultural use.

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Policies Affecting the Proposal

In considering all the relevant Provincial legislation, County and Township policies and regulations, Planning staff offer the following comments:

Provincial Planning Statement, 2024

The Provincial Planning Statement (PPS) is issued under Section 3 of the Planning Act and provides policy direction on matters of provincial interest related to land use planning and development. The PPS provides for appropriate development while protecting resources of provincial interest, public health and safety, and the quality of the natural and built environment. In respect of the exercise of any authority that affects a planning matter, the Planning Act requires that decisions affecting planning matters "shall be consistent" with policy statements issued under the Act. The PPS is to be read in its entirety and the relevant policies are to be applied to each situation. Therefore, only excerpts from the PPS pertinent to the proposal are highlighted below.

The PPS strongly encourages the protection of prime agricultural areas for long-term use for agriculture. Section 2 of the PPS states that lot creation in prime agricultural areas is discouraged and may only be permitted for a residence surplus to a farming operation as a result of farm consolidation, provided that:

- (1) the new lot will be limited to a minimum size needed to accommodate the use and appropriate sewage and water services, and;
- (2) the planning authority ensures that new residential dwellings are prohibited on any remnant parcel of farmland created by the severance.

The dwelling and associated structures located on the subject lands can be considered surplus to the needs of the bone fide farmer. The applicant proposes a lot area of approximately 1.2 ha to accommodate the existing detached dwelling, accessory structures and septic system.

Based on this review, it is staff's opinion that the proposal is consistent with the relevant provisions of the PPS.

Grey County Official Plan

Schedule A of the County OP designates the subject lands as 'Agricultural' and 'Hazard Lands'. Section 5.2.3(1) states that,

b) Where a house is deemed surplus to a farm operation as a result of farm consolidation, a lot may be severed provided that:

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- 1) The owner of the lands to be severed is a 'bona fide farmer', or as a condition of the consent application the lands will be sold to a 'bona fide farmer'. For the purposes of this policy, the 'bona fide farmer' must have a farm business registration number. A 'bona fide farmer' is defined to include a limited company, sole proprietorship, incorporated company, numbered company, partnership, and other similar ownership forms.
- 2) The lot proposed for the surplus farmhouse (and accessory buildings if applicable) will be limited in area and shall only be of sufficient size to accommodate the surplus farmhouse to the farming operation, accessory buildings (including any unused livestock facility, if this does not make the lot excessively large), a well, and a sewage treatment and disposal system, while ensuring that as little land as possible is removed from the agricultural lands.
- 3) Unless added onto an abutting farm parcel that already contains a dwelling, the remnant farm parcel shall be rezoned to prohibit the future construction of a new residential dwelling of any type.
- 4) The severance of a surplus farmhouse shall comply with Provincial MDS Formulae. For the purposes of this section, only livestock facilities situated on the farm parcel from which the surplus farmhouse is being severed, shall be used in determining Provincial MDS Formulae compliance
- 5) Given that no new house can be built as a result of the surplus farmhouse being severed from the land holding, the requirements for an environmental impact study, do not apply; however no new surplus farmhouse severances will be permitted in the Aggregate Resource Areas identified on Schedule B to this Plan; and,
- 6) The existing farmhouse is habitable at the time of application.
- 7) If an existing livestock facility is located within close vicinity of the surplus farmhouse, it is recommended that it be included in the severed parcel and be converted to a decommissioned livestock facility.
- 8) If a livestock barn is located on the retained parcel and fails to meet MDS requirements relating to a severed surplus farmhouse, it is recommended that it be converted to a decommissioned livestock barn.
- 9) Policies 5.6.2(8) and 5.6.6(2) shall not constrain a surplus farmhouse severance. Non-farm size lot creation (i.e., the surplus farmhouse and accessory buildings if applicable) may be considered under this policy section where an Aggregate Resource Area, Bedrock Resource Area and/or Shale Resource Area has been identified.



Given that a zoning amendment will be enacted as a condition of severance restricting new residential dwellings on the retained parcels, the proposed severance will comply with the Severance and Natural Heritage policies contained in the County Plan.

Township of Georgian Bluffs Zoning By-law 2020-020

The subject lands are zoned as Agricultural (AG) and Environmental Protection (EP) in the Township's Zoning By-law. A zoning by-law amendment, restricting new residential development on the retained lands, will need to be implemented as a condition of severance.

Strategic Plan Alignment: This report supports the delivery of core services.

Relevant Consultation

Notice of Complete Application and Notice of Public Hearing was circulated on September 16, 2025, to various agencies for review. The following comments were received:

County of Grey Planning and Development Services comments dated October 3, 2025:

"Provided Georgian Bluffs staff are satisfied that the provided justification addresses the criteria in Section 5.2.3(1)(b) and County Transportation Services comments are addressed; County Planning staff have no concerns with the subject application."

Saugeen Ojibway Nation (SON) comments dated May 14, 2025:

"SON does not require assessments for Mrs. Van Loo's property."

Hydro One Networks Inc. comments dated October 2, 2025:

"We are in receipt of your Application for Consent, B14/25 dated 2025-09-16. We have reviewed the documents concerning the noted Plan and have no comments or concerns at this time. Our preliminary review considers issues affecting Hydro One's 'High Voltage Facilities and Corridor Lands' only."

GEI Canada comments dated September 17, 2025:

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"This property is within the Drainage Area of a Municipal Drain, specifically the Webb Municipal Drain.

Should the landowner wish to continue to sever their lot, a condition of approval would be that the owner obtain a Section 65 Report for their proposed severance. The report would only be created once the severance is approved (on the condition that a Section 65 Report is obtained).

We would require a sketch of the proposed severance from the landowner to complete this report."

Grey Sauble Conservation Authority (GSCA) comments dated October 7, 2025:

"GSCA has no objections to the proposed consent and zoning by-law amendment applications as it is not anticipated to impact any areas regulated by Ontario Regulation 41/24 and/or natural hazard features."

Conclusion & Recommendation

It has been demonstrated that the proposed application B14/25 is consistent with the PPS and complies with the Grey County Official Plan and the general intent and purpose of the Township of Georgian Bluffs Zoning By-law 2020-020. Accordingly, it is recommended that the application be approved with the following conditions applied:

- That a Reference Plan be completed, and a copy filed with the Municipal Clerk or an exemption from the Reference Plan be received from the Land Registry Office.
- 2. That, pursuant to Section 53(42) of the Planning Act, the 'Certificate of Consent' be affixed to the deed within two years of the giving of the Notice of Decision. Note: Section 53(43) of the Planning Act requires that the transaction approved by this consent must be carried out within two years of the issuance of the certificate (i.e., stamping of the deed).
- 3. That the applicant pays the applicable consent certification fee at the time of certification of the deeds.
- 4. 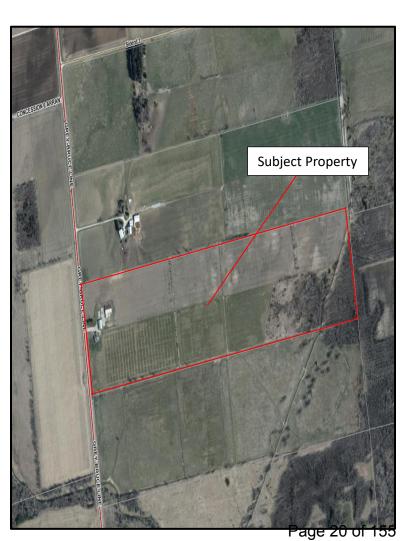

What is proposed?

The purpose of Application B14/25 is to sever approximately 1.24-hectare of land containing a dwelling and accessory structures from a 40.91-hectare agricultural property as a surplus farm dwelling severance. 39.67-hectares will be retained for continued agricultural use.

Application Z-09-25 proposes to reduce the minimum lot area requirement of an agricultural lot in the 'AG' zone, as it applies to the retained parcel, from 40 hectares 39.6 hectares, and also to apply the "no dwelling" clause to this parcel, reduce the 'minimum lot area' requirement of a residential lot in the 'AG' zone, as it applies to the severed parcel, from 40 hectares to 1.2 hectares, and, increase the maximum lot coverage of the 'AG' zone, as it applies to the severed parcel, from 1% to 10% for the accessory buildings and from 10% to 14% for all buildings. No changes are proposed to the Environmental Protection (EP) Zone. No other relief to the By-law has been requested.

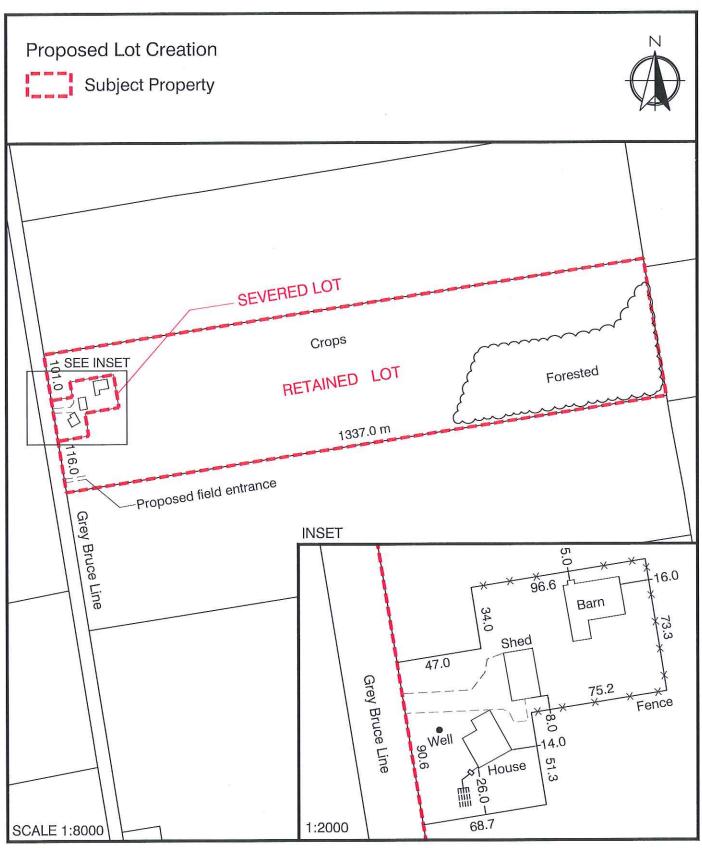

Further to recent pre-consultation discussions with your office and the County of Grey Planning Department regarding a lot line adjustment involving the above-noted property, enclosed please find a completed Consent application.

Also enclosed are cheques covering the Township application fee and GSCA review fee, as well as comments from Saugeen Ojibway Nation regarding the need for an archaeological assessment and an email from a lawyer pertaining to a cancellation of consent.

To assist your office with its evaluation of this matter, I offer the following:

Proposed Lot Creation:

Jeff Trask owns a 0.286-hectare residential lot on which his house and garage are located. A storage shed also exists partially on the subject property but is mostly situated on the neighbour's lot.

To the rear of Mr. Trask's property, also on the neighbour's farm parcel of land, is a barn that has been used for storage by Mr. Trask for many years, with the support of the neighbour, Elizabeth Van Loo.

The two respective landowners are proposing a lot line adjustment that would have the effect of widening the existing residential lot to include the small shed and extending the depth of this parcel such that the Trask lot will include the storage barn. The land conveyance would involve 0.279 hectares of land. Mr. Trask's lot would increase in size to 0.565 hectares and Mrs. Van Loo's farm parcel would be reduced to 41.62 hectares.

The lot line adjustment is illustrated on the attached sketch.

No land currently used for agricultural purposes will be lost.

The existing driveway providing a second means of access to the storage barn will remain with the farm. It will be shortened and continue to provide access for farm machinery to the cropped fields.

The lot line on the east side of the expanded Trask property will extend through a concrete barnyard. A portion of the barnyard to be retained with the farm holding would have the concrete base removed in the future and restored to an agricultural field.

Approvals Required:

Adjusting the property boundary between the two existing parcels requires approval of a Consent application by the Township of Georgian Bluffs.

In order for the 0.279-hectare severed parcel to merge with Mr. Trask's existing lot, the original consent that was granted for this parcel must be cancelled, as confirmed in an email from Andrew Drury, solicitor for Mr. Trask.

The Subject Lands:

The Van Loo and Trask properties are located along the north side of A Line, in the former Township of Derby.

The Van Loo property comprises 41.9 hectares of land, of which approximately 25 hectares are cash cropped. A 16.5-hectare forest exists at the rear of this property. The barn is not capable of accommodating livestock and is used only for storage. This parcel is actually

registered in the name of Elizabeth Van Loo and the Estate of Cornelius Van Loo. Elizabeth is the executor of the estate.

The Trask property involves 0.295 hectares of land and is occupied by an old farmhouse that have been tastefully restored and expanded, as well as a garage and a shed that straddles the westerly property boundary.

Adjacent Lands:

Agriculture is the predominant land use within the general vicinity of the Van Loo property, although several residential lots have been severed along A Line, to the east and west of the site. The lands to the north are forested.

Township of Georgian Bluffs Zoning By-law:

The subject property is zoned 'AG' in the Township's Zoning By-law.

The minimum lot area and frontage requirements of the 'AG' zone for "agricultural uses" are 40 hectares and 200 metres, respectively. The retained parcel will comprise 41.62 hectares of land and will therefore conform to this minimum standard.

With regard to the severed parcel, the Township's Zoning By-law does not include minimum requirements for lot area or frontage for "residential and non-agricultural uses" in the 'AG' zone, but does state that a lot of 2.0 hectares in size or smaller shall be considered as "residential and non-agricultural lots". Given that the expanding residential lot will remain under 2.0 hectares, no relief from the Zoning By-law is required.

County of Grey Official Plan:

The subject lands fall within the jurisdiction of the County of Grey Official Plan. No local Official Plan is in effect for this area of the Township.

According to Schedule A of the County Official Plan, the entirety of both properties involved with this lot line adjustment are designated 'Agricultural'.

The intent of the 'Agricultural' designation is generally to prohibit non-farm lot creation, with some exceptions, and to keep lots as large as possible to promote viable farming operations.

The Official Plan has established a minimum lot area policy of 40 hectares for farm parcels that are designated 'Agricultural'. The retained parcel will exceed this minimum standard.

The existing residential lot is only 0.295 hectares in size and is proposed to be increased to 0.565 hectares.

The consent policies allow for lot line adjustments for legal or technical reasons, with the Official Plan providing the following definition:

LEGAL OR TECHNICAL REASONS means severance for purposes such as easements, corrections of deeds, quit claims, and minor boundary adjustments, which do not result in the creation of a new lot

During the pre-consultation discussions, the Georgian Bluffs Planning Department staff confirmed that the proposal – which will not result in the creation of a new lot – will be viewed as a minor boundary adjustment and therefore qualify as a lot line adjustment for "legal or technical reasons".

In support of this land conveyance, please consider the following:

- 1. The existing residential lot is very small by today's standards. Privately serviced lots under 0.4 hectares are uncommon due to Provincial standards pertaining to nitrate levels. In fact, new lots in the 'Rural' designation are required to have an area of at least 0.8 hectares. Following the lot line adjustment, the expanded lot will still only comprise 0.565 hectares, but it does nevertheless represent an improvement to an existing situation;
- 2. If the Trask property had never been severed and the house and accessory buildings still formed part of the Van Loo farm, the severance of the farmhouse would likely be approved under the "surplus farmhouse" consent policies, since Mrs. Van Loo would qualify for such a severance; and, such severance would certainly include the existing storage barn;
- 3. Expanding the residential lot to the west will correct an encroachment issue involving a shed and a landscaped lawn that existed since the lot was created in 1975;
- 4. Expanding the lot to the rear will allow Mr. Trask to take ownership of a barn that he has used for several years, a barn which serves no purpose to Mrs. Van Loo or her farming operation. This lot addition, therefore, has merit from a practical or common sense perspective;

- 5. No land will be removed from agricultural production as a result of this lot line adjustment; and,
- 6. With the barn forming part of the residential lot, there is no opportunity for a future owner of the Van Loo farm to revert this structure to a livestock facility, which would have created a land use compatibility issue pertaining to odour.

In view of the foregoing, the proposed severance conforms to the 'Agricultural' consent policies of the Grey County Official Plan.

Other policies of the Official Plan also must be considered, as follows:

The forested lands at the rear of the property are identified as 'Significant Woodlands' on Appendix B and 'Natural Heritage System: Core' on Schedule C. The intent of this mapping and associated policies is to protect this natural heritage feature from development and site alteration. The lot line adjustment is occurring approximately 490 metres from the woodland, and therefore this feature will not be impacted. The proposal conforms to the policies on the Official Plan in this regard.

In addition, some of the lands at the rear of the property are also shown as 'Karst' on Appendix A. This particular area is approximately 570 metres from the expanding residential lot, and therefore a karst study investigating the suitability of the site to accommodate a building(s), septic system, etc., is unnecessary.

Furthermore, the 'Bedrock Drift Thickness: 1 m to 8 m' constraint applies to a portion of the existing residential lot, the area to be severed, and some of the retained lands. The intent of this policy is to protect a possible bedrock resource for future extraction from development that might otherwise interfere with a possible quarry operation. Typically, the viability of extraction activity is to be considered before allowing for lot creation. In this particular instance, however, the intent of this policy would not be undermined by a 0.279-hectare expansion of an existing residential lot.

Based on the foregoing, the proposed lot line adjustment conforms to the County of Grey Official Plan.

Provincial Planning Statement:

The Provincial Planning Statement (PPS) is the basis for the aforementioned policies contained in the County and Township Official Plans pertaining to lot creation and lot line

adjustments in prime agricultural areas. Based on the merit provided above, the proposed conveyance is deemed to be consistent with said policies.

The PPS also contains policies that serve to protect natural heritage features, potential sources of aggregate materials, and lands exhibiting karstic features. As explained above, the proposed lot line adjustment would not conflict with such policies.

Moreover, the PPS protects areas of archaeological significance. On this note, Saugeen Ojibway Nation (SON) has advised than an Archaeological Assessment is not required for these lands. A copy of the correspondence with SON is included in this submission.

Based on the foregoing, the proposed severance is deemed consistent with the PPS.

Conclusion:

The proposed lot line adjustment conforms with the Grey County Official Plan and is consistent with the Provincial Planning Statement. The submitted Consent application should therefore be given favourable consideration.

As noted above, the original consent granted for the Trask property will need to cancelled in order for the merging to occur. This should be identified as a condition imposed by the Committee of Adjustment.

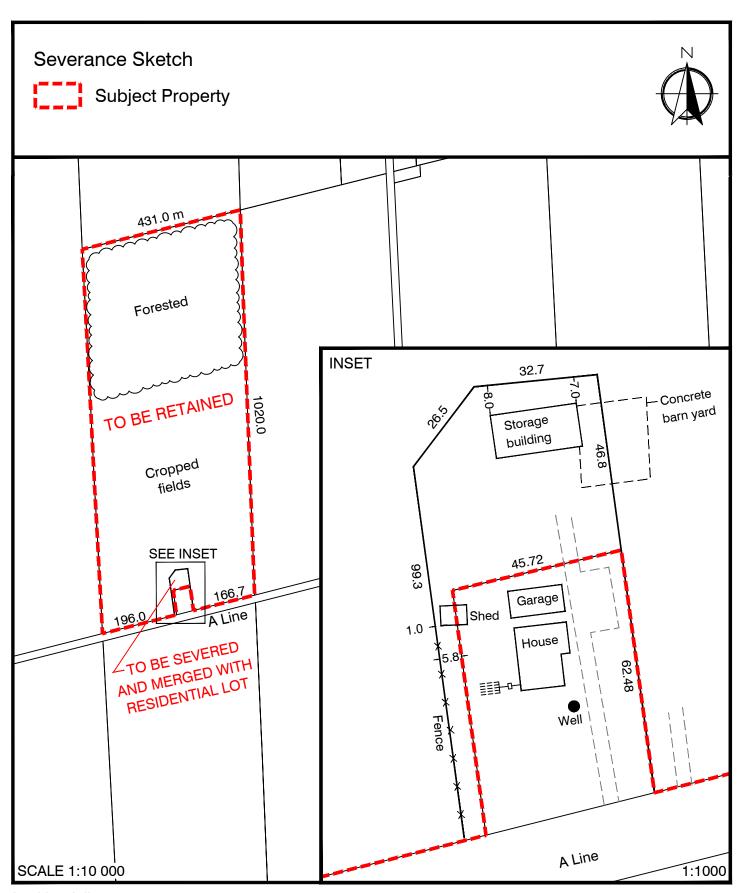

This correspondence is in response to the above noted application. We have had an opportunity to review the application in relation to the Provincial Planning Statement (PPS) and the County of Grey Official Plan (OP). We offer the following comments.

The purpose and effect of the subject application is to sever approximately 1.24-hectare of land containing a dwelling and accessory structures from a 40.91-hectare agricultural property as a surplus farm dwelling severance. 39.67-hectares will be retained for continued agricultural use. The purpose and effect of the zoning by-law amendment application is to reduce the minimum lot area requirement of an agricultural lot in the 'AG' zone, as it applies to the retained parcel, from 40 hectares 39.6 hectares, and also to apply the "no dwelling" clause to this parcel, reduce the 'minimum lot area' requirement of a residential lot in the 'AG' zone, as it applies to the severed parcel, from 40 hectares to 1.2 hectares, and, increase the maximum lot coverage of the 'AG' zone, as it applies to the severed parcel, from 1% to 10% for the accessory buildings and from 10% to 14% for all buildings. No changes are proposed to the Environmental Protection (EP) Zone. No other relief to the By-law has been requested.

Schedule A of the County OP designates the subject lands as 'Agricultural'. Section 5.2.3(1) states,

Grey County: Colour It Your Way

- b) New residential lots are not permitted in the Agricultural land use type. Where a house is deemed surplus to a farm operation as a result of farm consolidation, a lot may be severed provided that:
 - 1) The owner of the lands to be severed is a 'bona fide farmer', or as a condition of the consent application the lands will be sold to a 'bona fide farmer'. For the purposes of this policy, the 'bona fide farmer' must have a farm business registration number. A 'bona fide farmer' is defined to include a limited company, sole proprietorship, incorporated company, numbered company, partnership, and other similar ownership forms.
 - 2) The lot proposed for the surplus farmhouse (and accessory buildings if applicable) will be limited in area and shall only be of sufficient size to accommodate the surplus farmhouse to the farming operation, accessory buildings (including any unused livestock facility, if this does not make the lot excessively large), a well, and a sewage treatment and disposal system, while ensuring that as little land as possible is removed from the agricultural lands.
 - 3) Unless added onto an abutting farm parcel that already contains a dwelling, the remnant farm parcel shall be rezoned to prohibit the future construction of a new residential dwelling of any type.
 - 4) The severance of a surplus farmhouse shall comply with Provincial MDS Formulae. For the purposes of this section, only livestock facilities situated on the farm parcel from which the surplus farmhouse is being severed, shall be used in determining Provincial MDS Formulae compliance
 - 5) Given that no new house can be built as a result of the surplus farmhouse being severed from the land holding, the requirements for an environmental impact study, do not apply; however no new surplus farmhouse severances will be permitted in the Aggregate Resource Areas identified on Schedule B to this Plan; and,
 - 6) The existing farmhouse is habitable at the time of application.
 - 7) If an existing livestock facility is located within close vicinity of the surplus farmhouse, it is recommended that it be included in the severed parcel and be converted to a decommissioned livestock facility.
 - 8) If a livestock barn is located on the retained parcel and fails to meet MDS requirements relating to a severed surplus farmhouse, it is recommended that it be converted to a decommissioned livestock barn.

9) Policies 5.6.2(8) and 5.6.6(2) shall not constrain a surplus farmhouse severance. Non-farm size lot creation (i.e., the surplus farmhouse and accessory buildings if applicable) may be considered under this policy section where an Aggregate Resource Area, Bedrock Resource Area and/or Shale Resource Area has been identified.

A Planning Justification Report was submitted with the application and addresses the criteria listed above. County Planning staff are satisfied that the justification provided addresses the criteria of Section 5.2.3(1)(b) of the County Official Plan. Provided Georgian Bluffs staff are satisfied that the provided justification addresses the criteria above; County Planning staff have no concerns.

Schedule A of the County OP indicates that the subject lands contain 'Hazard Lands'. The proposed severance is located outside of the Hazard Lands; therefore, County Planning staff have no concerns.

County Planning Ecology staff have reviewed the subject applications and have a comment stating,

Natural Heritage

The property contains and/or is adjacent to areas of natural and scientific interest, significant woodlands, significant wildlife habitat, and potential habitat for threatened and/or endangered species. It is staffs understanding that the proposed development will be located adjacent and within the features on previously disturbed and developed lands that will not impact ground water or bedrock resources. As such, it is staffs opinion that the potential impact to natural heritage would be negligible and the requirement for an Environmental Impact Study (EIS) can be waived.

Stormwater Management

It is staffs understanding that stormwater management infrastructure is not needed for the proposal.

Source Water Protection

<u>trails</u>. An exemption to the by-law includes the injuring or destruction of trees required in order to install and provide utilities to the construction or use of the building, structure or thing in respect of which a Building Permit has been issued.

County Transportation Services have reviewed the subject applications and have a comment stating,

No road widening is required. The proposed field entrance should be located 100 metres from the existing entrance for the severed lot.

Provided Georgian Bluffs staff are satisfied that the provided justification addresses the criteria in Section 5.2.3(1)(b) and County Transportation Services comments are addressed; County Planning staff have no concerns with the subject application.

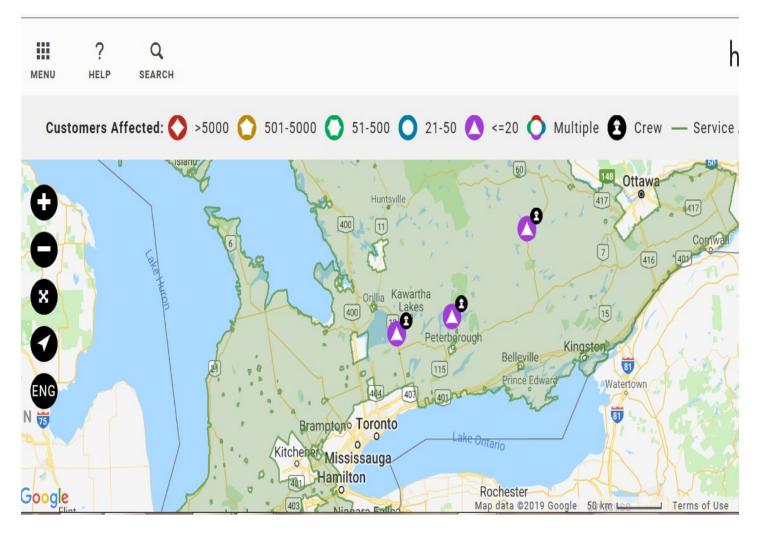

Grey Sauble Conservation Authority (GSCA) has reviewed the subject application in accordance with our mandate and policies for Natural Hazards under the Provincial Planning Statement and relative to our policies for the implementation of Ontario Regulation 41/24. We offer the following comments.

Subject Proposal

The proposed consent is to sever approximately 1.24 hectares of land containing a dwelling and accessory structures from a 40.91 hectare agricultural property as a surplus farm dwelling severance. 39.67 hectares will be retained for continued agricultural use.

The proposed zoning by-law amendment is recognize deficiencies in lot area for the severed and retained lots, apply a "no dwelling" clause to the retained lot, and increase the maximum lot coverage for the severed lot. No changes are proposed to the EP zone.

Site Description

The property is located on the east side of Grey-Bruce Line, just north of the Sullivan-Derby Townline, in the Township of Georgian Bluffs. The property features an existing single family dwelling on private services with accessory structures. Grades on the property are relatively flat and the overall property is primarily utilized for agricultural purposes.

GSCA Regulations

A portion of the property is mapped regulated by Ontario Regulation 41/24: Prohibited Activities, Exemptions and permits. The mapped regulated area is associated with a watercourse and low-lying areas in the eastern portion of the property.

Under this regulation a permit is required from this office prior to the construction, reconstruction, erection or placing of a building or structure of any kind; any change to a building or structure that would have the effect of altering the use or potential use of the building or structures, increasing the size of the building or structure, or increasing the number of dwelling units in the building or structure; site grading; or, the temporary or permanent placing, dumping or removal of any material originating on the site or elsewhere, if occurring within the regulated area. Also, a permit is required for interference with a wetland, and/or the

straightening, changing, diverting or in any way interfering with an existing channel of a river, lake, creek stream or watercourse.

There is engineered flood plain mapping available for the main channel of the Sauble River to the west of Grey-Bruce Line. Unfortunately, the mapping does not extend to the subject property. Based on the relatively flat grades, it is possible that there is unmapped flood plain on the subject property. However, given the nature of the application, no new development is anticipated.

Provincial Planning Statement 2024 5.2 Natural Hazards

The is mapped flood and erosion hazard associated with watercourses and low-lying areas in the eastern portion of the property. As noted, there is the potential for additional unmapped flood plain to affect other areas of the property. However, given the nature of the application and that no new physical development is anticipated, no technical information is requested to further explore this concern. With this, GSCA is satisfied that the proposal is consistent with the natural hazard policies of the PPS.

Saugeen, Grey Sauble, Northern Bruce Peninsula Source Protection Plan

The subject property is not located within an area that is subject to the Source Protection Plan.

Recommendations

GSCA has no objections to the proposed consent and zoning by-law amendment applications as it is not anticipated to impact any areas regulated by Ontario Regulation 41/24 and/or natural hazard features.

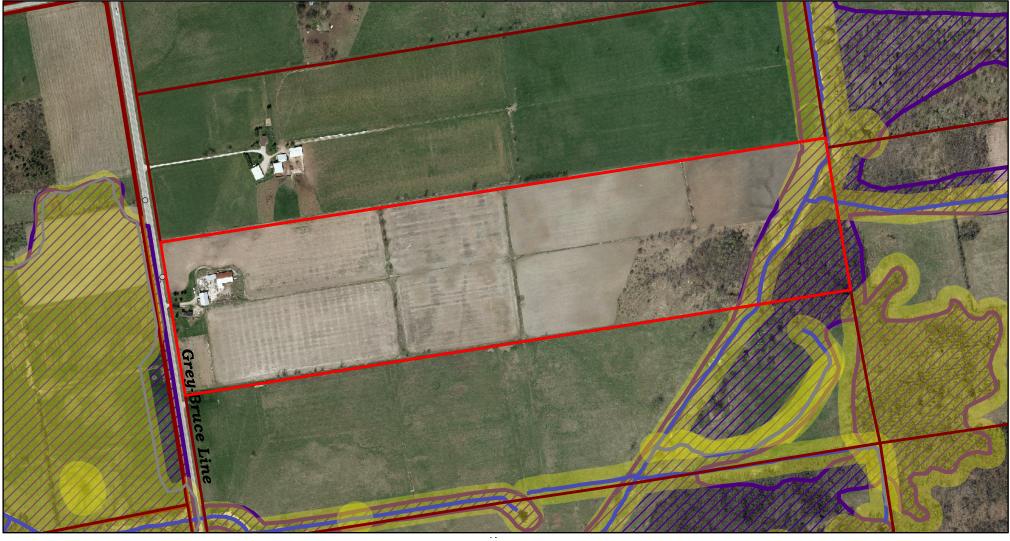

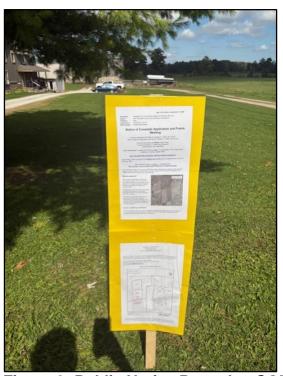


Figure 2: Public Notice Posted at CON B PT LOT 9 Roll Number: 4203-620-001-03801 on September 11, 2025.

Policies Affecting the Proposal

Minor Variance Application A07-25:

In considering the four tests for the minor variances as outlined in Section 45(1) of the Planning Act, R.S.O, 1990 Chap. P 13, as amended, Planning staff offers the following comments:

General Intent of the Official Plan

The subject lands are designated 'Subject to the County of Grey Official Plan' on Scheudle 'A' of the Township of Georgian Bluffs Official Plan and 'Agricultural' on Schedule 'A' of the County of Grey Official Plan (GCOP). It is noted that the subject lands are zoned for agricultural uses, and generally permit construction of an accessory structure on the lands.

As a result, Planning staff are of the opinion that the proposed variance maintains the general intent of the Official Plan.

General Intent of the Zoning By-law 2020-020

Staff note that the subject property is currently zoned Agriculutral (AG) within the Township of Georgian Bluffs Zoning By-law 2020-020. The purpose of the 2.0 metre side yard setback requirement for accessory structures is to ensure sufficient separation from adjacent property lines. This separation helps prevent encroachments and ensures that access to and maintenance of structures can be completed entirely within the boundaries of the subject property, without reliance on or impact to neighbouring lands.

In this case, the requested reduction in the side yard setback from 2.0 metres to 1.0 metre can be considered to maintain the intent of the Zoning By-law, as it improves an existing sites condition. Staff note that the accessory structure is not being altered in size or location. Additionally, staff note that the structure currently encroaches onto the adjacent parcel, however, the proposed lot line adjustment will result in the structure being located entirely within the boundaries of the subject property, thereby eliminating the encroachment, though, still requiring the 1.0 metre requested side yard setback variance.

Staff are of the opinion that this adjustment not only improves the existing site conditions but also ensures that stormwater runoff associated with the structure can now be managed entirely on the bennefitting property.

As a result, Planning staff are of the opinion that the proposed variance maintains the general intent and purpose of the Zoning By-law and represents a desirable and appropriate solution for the subject property.

Is/Are the Effects of the Variance(s) Minor?

The requested reduction in the setback of the accessory structure from the interior lot line can be considered minor in nature. This is due to the fact that the condition is existing, and no changes are proposed to the width or footprint of the accessory structure. In fact, the current structure encroaches onto the adjacent property, and the proposed lot line adjustment would resolve this issue. As such, the adjustment represents an improvement to the existing site conditions and is considered both desirable and appropriate for the subject property.

Planning staff do not anticipate any significant impacts or adverse effects resulting from the requested variance. Therefore, it is the opinion of Planning staff that the proposed variance is minor in nature and meets the intent of the applicable planning policies.

<u>Is/Are the Variance(s) Desirable For The Appropriate Development or Use of the Land,</u> Building and/or Structure?

The requested variance is considered a desirable and appropriate use as it will bring the accessory strucutre into further compliance with the Zoning By-law.

Consent Application B13-25:

In considering all the relevant Provincial legislation, County and Township policies and regulations, Planning staff offer the following comments pertaining to the proposed lot line adjustment:

Provincial Planning Statement, 2024

The Provincial Planning Statement 2024 (PPS) provides policy direction on matters of provincial interest related to land use planning and development. The subject application does not propose any development, rather it is an adjustment of lot lines. Planning Staff is of the opinion that the application is consistent with the PPS.

Grey County Official Plan

Staff note that the lands fall under the jurisdiction of the County of Grey Official Plan and that there is no local Official Plan currently in effect for this area of the Township, as Schedule A of the Township of Georgian Bluffs Official Plan indicates that the lands are regulated by the County of Greys Official Plan.

According to Schedule A of the County Official Plan, both properties involved in the application are designated as 'Agricultural.' The intent of this designation is to generally prohibit non-farm lot creation, with limited exceptions, and to maintain large parcel sizes to support viable agricultural operations.

Township Staff note that the proposed retained lot will exceed the minimum lot area of 40 hectares required for farm parcels that are designated Agricultural.

Planning staff are of the opinion that the proposed lot line adjustment is consistent with the intent of the County of Grey Official Plan. The retained parcel will continue to exceed the minimum lot area required for agricultural use, and the adjustment results in an increase to the size of the benefiting parcel. As both parcels are already legally severed, the proposal does not constitute the creation of a new lot, but rather a lot line adjustment.

Appendix E of the County OP indicates that the subject lands contain 'Bedrock Drift Thickness 1m to 8m'. Section 5.6.6(3) states, Minor lot additions to existing lots may be permitted in Bedrock and Shale Resource Areas, if the following criteria can be met:

- Demonstrate the appropriateness of the land area to be severed (i.e. land need, boundary error, servicing, parking, etc.);
- Demonstrate that the outcomes of the lot addition will not unduly impact future resource extraction, both from an availability of land and potential land use conflict perspective,
- Demonstrate the need for the lot addition,
- Demonstrate that the policies of section 5 of this Plan are addressed, and
 To explain the hardship imposed by not permitting the severance. All reasonable
 efforts shall be made to minimize any impacts on the Bedrock and Shale
 Resource Areas through any lot additions. Lot additions for the purposes of
 consolidating resource lands may be permitted, provided a new non-farm sized
 lot is not created. Lot adjustments in the Agricultural land use type and Special
 Agricultural land use type may only be permitted for legal or technical reasons.

Township staff are satisfied that the provided justification addresses the criteria in Section 5.6.6(3); and thus, Staff have no concerns.

As a result, Planning Staff are of the opinion that that the proposed lot line adjustment maintains the intent of the County of Grey Official Plan.

Township of Georgian Bluffs Zoning By-law 2020-020

The subject property is zoned Agricultural (AG) under the Township of Georgian Bluffs Zoning By-law 2020-020.

The Agricultural zone requires a minimum lot area of 40 hectares and a minimum frontage of 200 metres for parcels intended for agricultural use. The retained parcel comprises approximately 41.62 hectares, thereby meeting the minimum zoning requirements for agricultural use. No zoning relief is required for the retained portion.

The severed parcel is proposed to be less than 2.0 hectares in size. Planning Staff note that the Township of Georgian Bluffs Zoning By-law 2020-020 does not specify minimum lot area or frontage requirements for residential or non-agricultural uses within the AG zone, it does state that any parcel 2.0 hectares or smaller shall be considered a residential or non-agricultural lot.

Given that the severed parcel falls within this size threshold, it is classified as a residential/non-agricultural lot. As the Zoning By-law does not prescribe minimum standards for such lots in the AG zone, no zoning relief is required for the severed parcel.

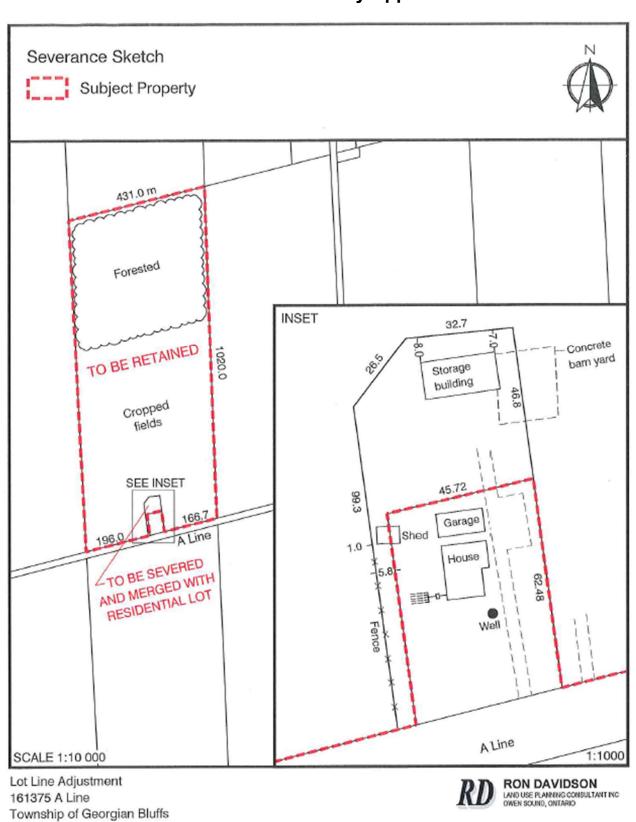

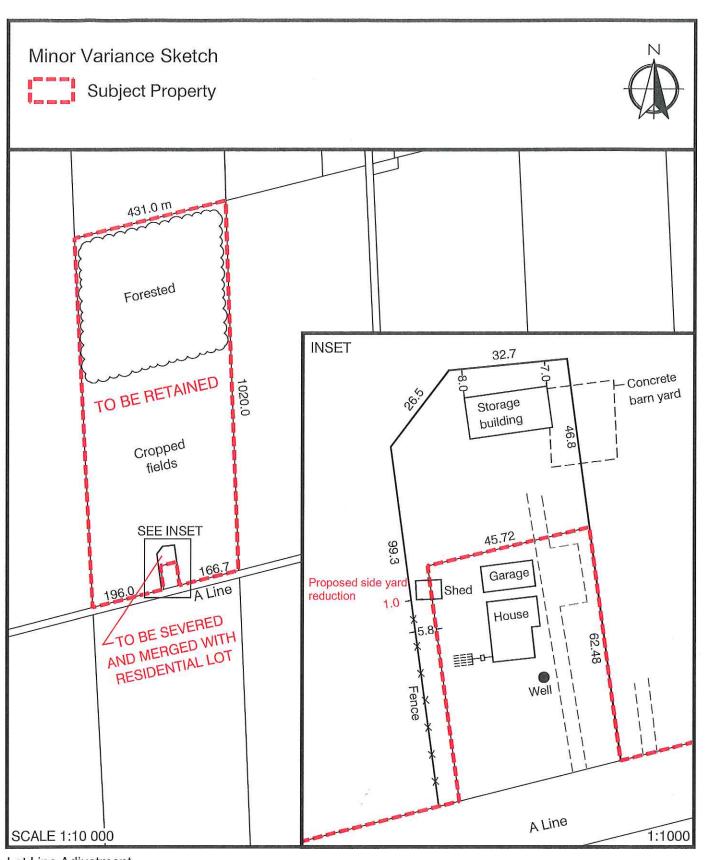

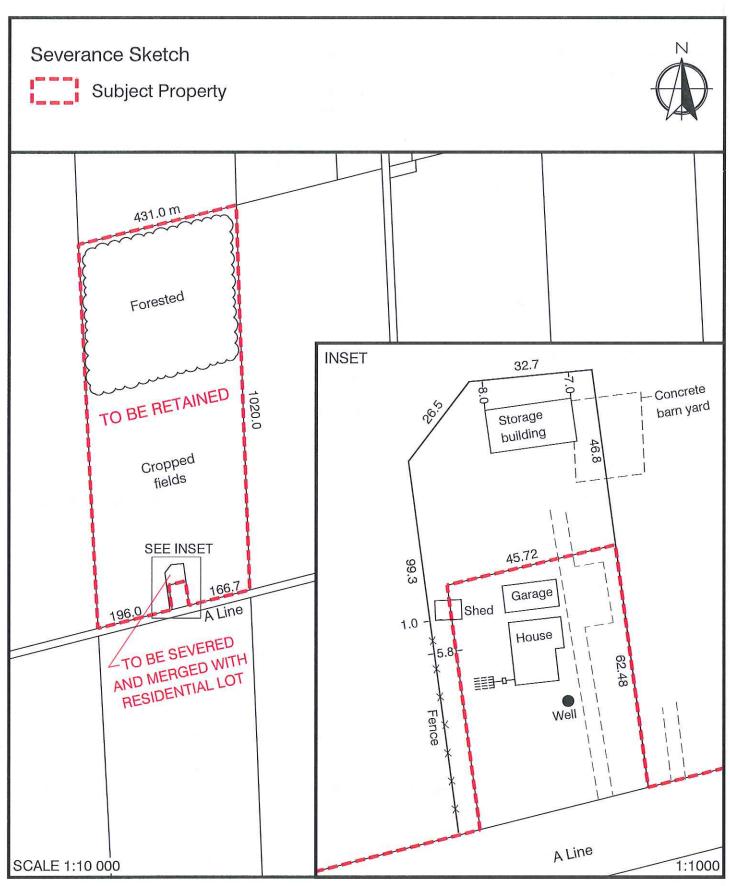

Further to last week's discussion regarding a recently submitted Consent application pertaining to a lot line adjustment involving the above-noted property, enclosed please find a Minor Variance application.

The cheques covering the Township's application fee and the Grey Sauble Conservation Authority review fee have already been delivered to your office.

To assist with your evaluation of this matter, I offer the following:

Proposed Minor Variance:

Recently, I filed a Consent application on behalf of Elizabeth Van Loo which is intended to convey 0.279 hectares of land to the adjacent residential lot owned by Jeff Trask. As a result of this conveyance, the storage building (former barn) located on the Van Loo property would form part of the Trask parcel. As well, the smaller storage shed that straddles the westerly lot line of the Trask property would then be situated entirely on the Trask parcel.

As your office has advised, the smaller storage shed – despite being located entirely on the Trask property following the lot boundary adjustment – would not comply with the 'minimum side yard' requirement for accessory buildings of 2.0 metres. Mr. Trask and I estimate the new side yard to be between 1.0 metres and 1.5 metres. The attached sketch shows a 1.0-metre yard, to be on the safe side. The submitted Minor Variance application will acknowledge this reduced side yard.

Minor Variance Evaluation:

Section 45(1) of the Planning Act lists four tests that a Minor Variance must pass in order to be approved. In this regard, please consider the following:

1. Does the variance maintain the intent and purpose of the Official Plan?

The subject lands are designated 'Agricultural' on Schedule A of the Grey County Official Plan. The Official Plan does not include policies that deal with the finer details of development on a property, such as side yards for accessory buildings. The Official Plan does, however, attempt to maximize the size of farm lots within the 'Agricultural' designated areas, and it would therefore generally favour a reduced side yard as opposed to making the residential lot larger and consuming more actively farmed land.

The proposed relief clearly maintains the intent and purpose of this land use policy document.

2. Does the variance maintain the intent and purpose of the Zoning By-law?

The 'AG' zone of the Township's Zoning By-law requires a 2.0-metre side yard to ensure that sufficient room exists on the property to provide maintenance to a building. A side yard of 1.0 - 1.5 metres should be sufficient to serve this purpose. It's worth noting that the proposed side yard is a significant improvement over the existing situation where approximately one-half of the building is located on the Van Loo farm property.

For these reasons, the proposal maintains the intent and purpose of the Zoning By-law.

3. Is the variance minor in nature?

This test has traditionally been interpreted as meaning "what impact will the variance have on the neighbours?" The only neighbour that could possibly be impacted by the reduced side yard on the Trask property would be Mrs. Van Loo. In that regard, if Mrs. Van Loo felt that a reduced side yard would create an imposition, she wouldn't be filing

the Consent and Minor Variance applications. The request should be considered minor in nature,

4. Is the variance requested desirable for the appropriate and orderly development and use of the lands and buildings?

The variance will facilitate a lot line adjustment that will eliminate an existing encroachment proposal. A 1.0 - 1.5 metre side yard is a considerable improvement over the existing situation.

This minor variance will result in the appropriate and orderly use of the Trask and Van Loo properties.

Conclusion:

The proposed Minor Variance passes the Planning Act's Minor Variance tests and should be given favourable consideration.

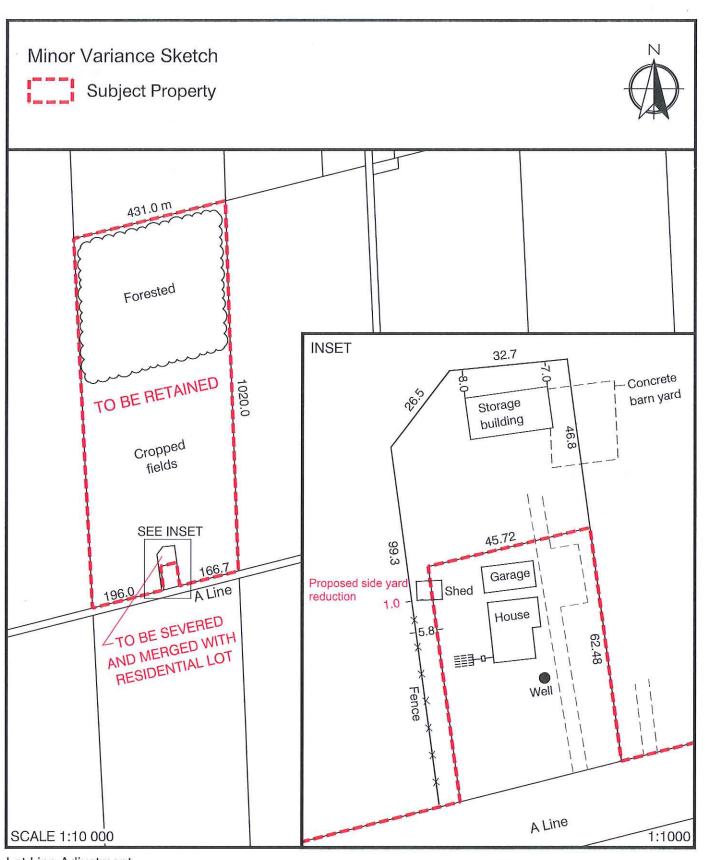

Further to recent pre-consultation discussions with your office and the County of Grey Planning Department regarding a lot line adjustment involving the above-noted property, enclosed please find a completed Consent application.

Also enclosed are cheques covering the Township application fee and GSCA review fee, as well as comments from Saugeen Ojibway Nation regarding the need for an archaeological assessment and an email from a lawyer pertaining to a cancellation of consent.

To assist your office with its evaluation of this matter, I offer the following:

Proposed Lot Creation:

Jeff Trask owns a 0.286-hectare residential lot on which his house and garage are located. A storage shed also exists partially on the subject property but is mostly situated on the neighbour's lot.

To the rear of Mr. Trask's property, also on the neighbour's farm parcel of land, is a barn that has been used for storage by Mr. Trask for many years, with the support of the neighbour, Elizabeth Van Loo.

The two respective landowners are proposing a lot line adjustment that would have the effect of widening the existing residential lot to include the small shed and extending the depth of this parcel such that the Trask lot will include the storage barn. The land conveyance would involve 0.279 hectares of land. Mr. Trask's lot would increase in size to 0.565 hectares and Mrs. Van Loo's farm parcel would be reduced to 41.62 hectares.

The lot line adjustment is illustrated on the attached sketch.

No land currently used for agricultural purposes will be lost.

The existing driveway providing a second means of access to the storage barn will remain with the farm. It will be shortened and continue to provide access for farm machinery to the cropped fields.

The lot line on the east side of the expanded Trask property will extend through a concrete barnyard. A portion of the barnyard to be retained with the farm holding would have the concrete base removed in the future and restored to an agricultural field.

Adjusting the property boundary between the two existing parcels requires approval of a Consent application by the Township of Georgian Bluffs.

In order for the 0.279-hectare severed parcel to merge with Mr. Trask's existing lot, the original consent that was granted for this parcel must be cancelled, as confirmed in an email from Andrew Drury, solicitor for Mr. Trask.

The Subject Lands:

The Van Loo and Trask properties are located along the north side of A Line, in the former Township of Derby.

The Van Loo property comprises 41.9 hectares of land, of which approximately 25 hectares are cash cropped. A 16.5-hectare forest exists at the rear of this property. The barn is not capable of accommodating livestock and is used only for storage. This parcel is actually

registered in the name of Elizabeth Van Loo and the Estate of Cornelius Van Loo. Elizabeth is the executor of the estate.

The Trask property involves 0.295 hectares of land and is occupied by an old farmhouse that have been tastefully restored and expanded, as well as a garage and a shed that straddles the westerly property boundary.

Adjacent Lands:

Agriculture is the predominant land use within the general vicinity of the Van Loo property, although several residential lots have been severed along A Line, to the east and west of the site. The lands to the north are forested.

Township of Georgian Bluffs Zoning By-law:

The subject property is zoned 'AG' in the Township's Zoning By-law.

The minimum lot area and frontage requirements of the 'AG' zone for "agricultural uses" are 40 hectares and 200 metres, respectively. The retained parcel will comprise 41.62 hectares of land and will therefore conform to this minimum standard.

With regard to the severed parcel, the Township's Zoning By-law does not include minimum requirements for lot area or frontage for "residential and non-agricultural uses" in the 'AG' zone, but does state that a lot of 2.0 hectares in size or smaller shall be considered as "residential and non-agricultural lots". Given that the expanding residential lot will remain under 2.0 hectares, no relief from the Zoning By-law is required.

County of Grey Official Plan:

The subject lands fall within the jurisdiction of the County of Grey Official Plan. No local Official Plan is in effect for this area of the Township.

According to Schedule A of the County Official Plan, the entirety of both properties involved with this lot line adjustment are designated 'Agricultural'.

The intent of the 'Agricultural' designation is generally to prohibit non-farm lot creation, with some exceptions, and to keep lots as large as possible to promote viable farming operations.

The Official Plan has established a minimum lot area policy of 40 hectares for farm parcels that are designated 'Agricultural'. The retained parcel will exceed this minimum standard.

The existing residential lot is only 0.295 hectares in size and is proposed to be increased to 0.565 hectares.

The consent policies allow for lot line adjustments for legal or technical reasons, with the Official Plan providing the following definition:

LEGAL OR TECHNICAL REASONS means severance for purposes such as easements, corrections of deeds, quit claims, and minor boundary adjustments, which do not result in the creation of a new lot.

During the pre-consultation discussions, the Georgian Bluffs Planning Department staff confirmed that the proposal – which will not result in the creation of a new lot – will be viewed as a minor boundary adjustment and therefore qualify as a lot line adjustment for "legal or technical reasons".

In support of this land conveyance, please consider the following:

- 1. The existing residential lot is very small by today's standards. Privately serviced lots under 0.4 hectares are uncommon due to Provincial standards pertaining to nitrate levels. In fact, new lots in the 'Rural' designation are required to have an area of at least 0.8 hectares. Following the lot line adjustment, the expanded lot will still only comprise 0.565 hectares, but it does nevertheless represent an improvement to an existing situation;
- 2. If the Trask property had never been severed and the house and accessory buildings still formed part of the Van Loo farm, the severance of the farmhouse would likely be approved under the "surplus farmhouse" consent policies, since Mrs. Van Loo would qualify for such a severance; and, such severance would certainly include the existing storage barn;
- 3. Expanding the residential lot to the west will correct an encroachment issue involving a shed and a landscaped lawn that existed since the lot was created in 1975;
- 4. Expanding the lot to the rear will allow Mr. Trask to take ownership of a barn that he has used for several years, a barn which serves no purpose to Mrs. Van Loo or her farming operation. This lot addition, therefore, has merit from a practical or common sense perspective;

- 5. No land will be removed from agricultural production as a result of this lot line adjustment; and,
- 6. With the barn forming part of the residential lot, there is no opportunity for a future owner of the Van Loo farm to revert this structure to a livestock facility, which would have created a land use compatibility issue pertaining to odour.

In view of the foregoing, the proposed severance conforms to the 'Agricultural' consent policies of the Grey County Official Plan.

Other policies of the Official Plan also must be considered, as follows:

The forested lands at the rear of the property are identified as 'Significant Woodlands' on Appendix B and 'Natural Heritage System: Core' on Schedule C. The intent of this mapping and associated policies is to protect this natural heritage feature from development and site alteration. The lot line adjustment is occurring approximately 490 metres from the woodland, and therefore this feature will not be impacted. The proposal conforms to the policies on the Official Plan in this regard.

In addition, some of the lands at the rear of the property are also shown as 'Karst' on Appendix A. This particular area is approximately 570 metres from the expanding residential lot, and therefore a karst study investigating the suitability of the site to accommodate a building(s), septic system, etc., is unnecessary.

Furthermore, the 'Bedrock Drift Thickness: 1 m to 8 m' constraint applies to a portion of the existing residential lot, the area to be severed, and some of the retained lands. The intent of this policy is to protect a possible bedrock resource for future extraction from development that might otherwise interfere with a possible quarry operation. Typically, the viability of extraction activity is to be considered before allowing for lot creation. In this particular instance, however, the intent of this policy would not be undermined by a 0.279-hectare expansion of an existing residential lot.

Based on the foregoing, the proposed lot line adjustment conforms to the County of Grey Official Plan.

Provincial Planning Statement:

The Provincial Planning Statement (PPS) is the basis for the aforementioned policies contained in the County and Township Official Plans pertaining to lot creation and lot line

adjustments in prime agricultural areas. Based on the merit provided above, the proposed conveyance is deemed to be consistent with said policies.

The PPS also contains policies that serve to protect natural heritage features, potential sources of aggregate materials, and lands exhibiting karstic features. As explained above, the proposed lot line adjustment would not conflict with such policies.

Moreover, the PPS protects areas of archaeological significance. On this note, Saugeen Ojibway Nation (SON) has advised than an Archaeological Assessment is not required for these lands. A copy of the correspondence with SON is included in this submission.

Based on the foregoing, the proposed severance is deemed consistent with the PPS.

Conclusion:

The proposed lot line adjustment conforms with the Grey County Official Plan and is consistent with the Provincial Planning Statement. The submitted Consent application should therefore be given favourable consideration.

As noted above, the original consent granted for the Trask property will need to cancelled in order for the merging to occur. This should be identified as a condition imposed by the Committee of Adjustment.

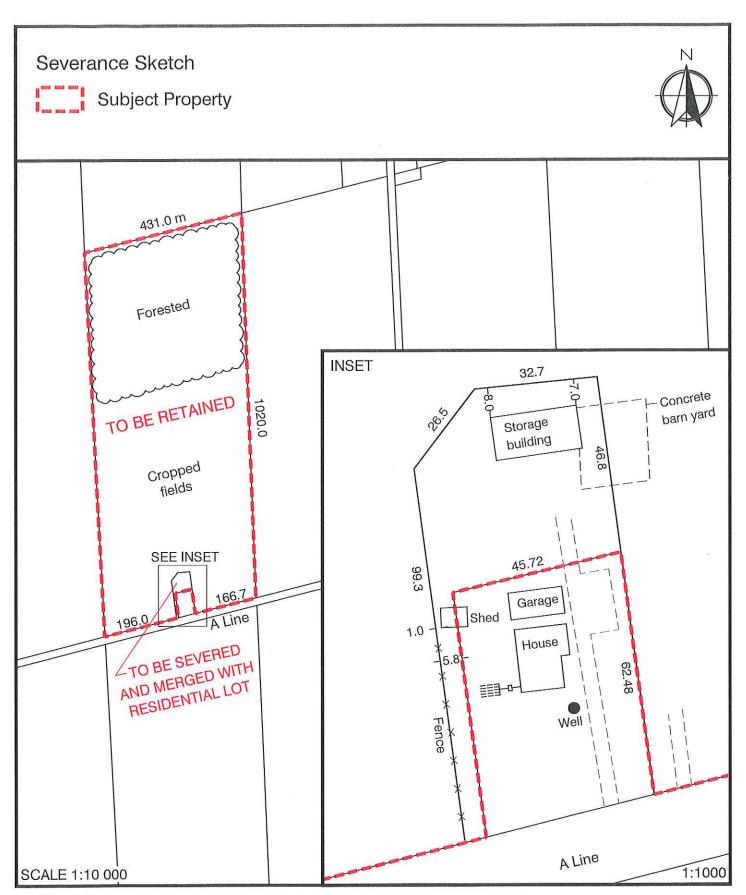

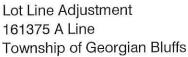

This correspondence is in response to the above noted application. We have had an opportunity to review the application in relation to the Provincial Planning Statement (PPS) and the County of Grey Official Plan (OP). We offer the following comments.

The purpose and effect of the subject application is to sever approximately 0.279 ha of land from the subject property for the purposes of a lot addition to the adjacent property located at 161375 A Line within the Township of Georgian Bluffs. The retained parcel will continue to be used for agricultural uses with no structures proposed at this time. No new lot will result from this lot addition. The purpose and effect of the minor variance application is to permit the reduction of the side yard requirement for accessory buildings in the Agricultural (AG) zone from 2.0 metres to 1.0 metres in order to recognize the location of the existing building.

Schedule A of the County OP designates the subject lands as 'Agricultural'. Section 5.2.3(3) states,

Lot adjustments in the Agricultural land use type may only be permitted for legal or technical reasons.

The County Official Plan defines legal or technical reasons as:

Grey County: Colour It Your Way

Severances for purposes such as easements, corrections of deeds, quit claims, and minor boundary adjustments, which do not result in the creation of a new lot.

The proposed lot addition is relatively minor and would remove future MDS conflicts if the existing barn were to be used for livestock in the future. Further, the proposed lot addition would enlarge the existing undersized lot to a more adequate size. In addition, the proposed lot addition would not remove active farmland from the retained lot. Therefore, County Planning staff have no concerns.

Schedule C of the County Official Plan indicates that the subject lands contain 'Core Area'. The proposed lot addition is located outside of the Core Area; therefore, County Planning staff have no concerns.

Appendix A of the County OP indicates the subject property contains 'Karst'. The proposed lot addition is outside of the area containing Karst; therefore, County Planning staff have no concerns.

County Planning Ecology staff have reviewed the subject application and have a comment stating,

Natural Heritage

The property contains and/or is adjacent to natural heritage core area, significant woodlands, significant wildlife habitat, and potential habitat for threatened and/or endangered species. It is staffs understanding that the proposed development will be located adjacent to the features on previously disturbed and developed lands. As such, it is staffs opinion that the potential impact to natural heritage would be negligible and the requirement for an Environmental Impact Study (EIS) can be waived.

Stormwater Management

It is staffs understanding that stormwater management infrastructure is not needed for the proposal.

Source Water Protection

It is staffs understanding that the property does not contain protection areas that are subject to policies of the Source Water Protection Act.

Should the applicant seek to injure or destruct trees on lands that extend more than 15 metres from the outer edge of which a Building Permit has been issued, staff recommend consulting the County's Forestry Management By-law http://grey.ca/forests-

<u>trails</u>. An exemption to the by-law includes the injuring or destruction of trees required in order to install and provide utilities to the construction or use of the building, structure or thing in respect of which a Building Permit has been issued.

Appendix E of the County OP indicates that the subject lands contain 'Bedrock Drift Thickness 1m to 8m'. Section 5.6.6(3) states,

Minor lot additions to existing lots may be permitted in Bedrock and Shale Resource Areas, if the following criteria can be met:

- Demonstrate the appropriateness of the land area to be severed (i.e. land need, boundary error, servicing, parking, etc.);
- Demonstrate that the outcomes of the lot addition will not unduly impact future resource extraction, both from an availability of land and potential land use conflict perspective,
- Demonstrate the need for the lot addition,
- Demonstrate that the policies of section 5 of this Plan are addressed, and
- To explain the hardship imposed by not permitting the severance.

All reasonable efforts shall be made to minimize any impacts on the Bedrock and Shale Resource Areas through any lot additions.

Lot additions for the purposes of consolidating resource lands may be permitted, provided a new non-farm sized lot is not created.

Lot adjustments in the Agricultural land use type and Special Agricultural land use type may only be permitted for legal or technical reasons.

A Planning Justification Report was submitted with the applications County Planning staff are satisfied that the provided justification addresses the criteria listed above. Provided Georgian Bluffs staff are satisfied that the provided justification addresses the criteria in Section 5.6.6(3); County Planning staff have no concerns.

Provided Georgian Bluffs staff are satisfied that the provided justification addresses the criteria in Section 5.6.6(3); County Planning staff have no concerns with the subject application.

The County requests notice of any decision rendered with respect to this file.

Policies Affecting the Proposal

In considering all the relevant Provincial legislation, County and Township policies and regulations, Planning staff offer the following comments:

Provincial Planning Statement (PPS, 2024)

The Provincial Planning Statement (PPS) is issued under Section 3 of the Planning Act and came into effect on October 20th, 2024. The PPS provides policy direction on matters of provincial interest related to land use planning and development, helping achieve the provincial goal of meeting the needs of a fast-growing province while enhancing the quality of life for all Ontarians. In respect of the exercise of any authority that affects a planning matter, the Planning Act requires that decisions affecting planning matters "shall be consistent" with policy statements issued under the Act.

The following outlines the key PPS policies that have been considered, though, it is not intended to be an exhaustive list.

According to Section 2.1.4, to provide for an appropriate range of housing options and densities required to meet projected requirements of current and future residents of the regional market area, planning authorities shall:

- maintain at all times the ability to accommodate residential growth for a minimum of 15 years through lands which are designated and available for residential development; and
- maintain at all times where new development is to occur, land with servicing capacity sufficient to provide at least a three-year supply of residential units available through lands suitably zoned, including units in draft approved or registered plans.

Further, Section 2.3.1 directs that settlement areas shall be the focus of growth and development. According to Section 2.3.1.2, land use patterns within settlement areas shall be based on densities and a mix of land uses which efficiently use land, resources, existing and planned infrastructure and public service facilities. Further, Planning authorities shall support general intensification and redevelopment to support the achievement of complete communities, including by planning for a range and mix of housing options and prioritizing planning and investment in the necessary infrastructure and public service facilities.

Staff have concluded that the application can be considered to be consistent with the PPS, if the recommended conditions of approval are implemented. Staff have included these recommendations in the draft conditions of approval.

County of Grey Official Plan (2018)

Per Schedule A to the County Official Plan, the subject lands are designated Secondary Settlement Area.

Settlement Area Policies

Section 3.5 of the County Official Plan directs secondary settlement areas to accommodate limited residential growth, in addition to new community facilities and employment uses. Policies under Section 3.3 of the County Official Plan affecting Settlement Area land use types encourage development within growth areas to occur adjacent to the existing built-up area and to have a compact form, mix of uses, and densities that allow for the efficient use of land, infrastructure, and public service facilities. These policies further encourage development of communities with a wide range of housing types, including detached, semi-detached, townhouse, and apartment units along with a mix of affordable housing, a range of alternative locations, forms and densities of housing, and price ranges to meet a variety of housing needs.

The future construction of a single-detached dwelling on the vacant parcel created by Application B19/25 is supported by the secondary settlement area policies contained within Section 3.5 of the County Official Plan. The subject lands are located within the existing built-up area and would allow for the efficient use of infrastructure and public service facilities located within the East Linton settlement area.

Servicing Policies

Where partial services exist in a Secondary Settlement Area, Section 3.5 of the County Official Plan only permits the development of vacant or underutilized lots, subject to satisfying the below criteria:

- The development is within the reserve sewage system capacity or reserve water system capacity;
- Site conditions are suitable for the long-term provision of such services;
- The development is within the existing settlement area;
- To allow for infilling and minor rounding out of existing development.

The subject lands are located within the boundaries of the existing East Linton Secondary Settlement Area. Township staff note that the East Linton municipal water system currently has sufficient reserve capacity to support the future development of a single-detached dwelling on the vacant parcel proposed through Application B19/25. While no servicing issues are anticipated, completion of the Servicing Options Study -

as required under Policy 8.9.1(10)(c) - will provide confirmation that the site can be viably serviced by municipal water and private sewage systems, and that the site conditions are appropriate for the long-term provision of such services. Based on the above, the application conforms to the relevant policies of the County Official Plan.

Township of Georgian Bluffs Official Plan

The subject lands are designated Residential per Schedule A to the Official Plan for the Township of Georgian Bluffs (Township Official Plan).

Policies under Section 3.4.1 of the Township Official Plan permit low density residential uses, including single-detached dwellings, as is proposed on the vacant parcel created by Application B19/25.

Housing Policies

General housing policies within Section 2.6.4 of the Township Official Plan state that the Township shall accommodate residential growth through intensification and redevelopment opportunities, and encourages intensification and infill as a means of increasing the housing supply, provided such projects are keeping with environmental considerations, adjacent land uses, and there is a demonstrated demand for the type of housing units under consideration. Policies within this section further identify a target of 15% of new residential development within primary and secondary settlement areas which is to occur through means of intensification, and a target of 75% of new residential development that is to be low density. Staff note that the proposed severance of the subject lands would therefore assist the Township in meeting its targets for low density residential development and for new residential development by way of intensification.

Adjacent land uses include low density residential use to the north, east, west and south of the subject lands. The proposed low density residential use is therefore compatible with the existing residential use of the area.

Servicing Policies

Section 2.10 of the Township Official Plan contains policies regarding servicing, which identify the presence of municipal water service in East Linton. Policies within this section state that future development is intended to proceed by way of individual sewage disposal systems in accordance with County and provincial policy and the completion of a Servicing Feasibility Study. This section further outlines criteria for development to occur on the basis of partial services, which include:

- It is within an existing settlement area;
- There is capacity in the municipal system or communal system;

- Suitable site conditions exist:
- The financial viability of the municipal services is enhanced;
- The protection of the environment is upheld;
- A Servicing Feasibility Study has been completed in accordance with Section policy 8.9.1(10)(c) to the satisfaction of the County and Township.

The subject lands are within the East Linton Secondary Settlement Area, and Township staff have confirmed that sufficient capacity exists within the municipal water system to accommodate the future construction of a single-detached dwelling on the proposed severed parcel. And as previously noted, the completion of the Servicing Options Study - as required under Policy 8.9.1(10)(c) - will provide confirmation that the site can be viably serviced by municipal water and private sewage systems, and that the site conditions are appropriate for the long-term provision of such services.

Based on the above, the application conforms to the relevant policies of the Township of Georgian Bluffs Official Plan.

Comprehensive Zoning By-law 2020-020

The subject lands are currently zoned Residential 1 (R1) in accordance with the Township of Georgian Bluffs Zoning By-law 2020-020.

The vacant parcel created by Application B19/25 has a lot area of approximately 1,606.24 square metres and frontage of approximately 30 m along Alexandria Street, in compliance with the minimum requirements of the R1 Zone (i.e., minimum lot area of 1,500 m² and minimum lot frontage of 30 m in areas with partial servicing). Future construction of the single-detached dwelling will be subject to the following requirements of the R1 Zone, which can be assessed at the building permit stage:

- Front Yard (min.): 7.5 m
- Rear Yard (min.): 6 m
- Interior Side Yard: 4.5 m
- Building Height (max.): 10 m
- Lot Coverage (max.): 20%

The existing single-detached dwelling and accessory structures on the parcel retained by Application B19/25 meets the requirements of the R1 Zone.

At this time, no relief has been requested from the above requirements of the R1 Zone.

Should the future single-detached dwelling fail to meet the above requirements, the applicant will be required to address any deficiencies through a subsequent application.

Relevant Consultation

Notice of Complete Application and Notice of Public Hearing was circulated on September 23, 2025, to various agencies for review. The following comments were received:

Grey Sauble Risk Management Office (RMO) comments dated September 23, 2025:

"From the information noted in the application for sever vacant land intended for future residential building use, it has been determined that neither section 57 (Prohibited Activities) nor section 58 (Regulated Activities) applies on the above-noted property, pursuant to the *Clean Water Act*, 2006.

Consequently, no policies apply to the activities identified in the application, under the approved Source Protection Plan for the Saugeen, Grey Sauble, Northern Bruce Peninsula Source Protection Region (effective July 1, 2016). However, it is important to note that the above property is located within the Events-based Area for the East Linton Drinking Water Systems, whereby the storage of fuel greater than 2,500L in this area is regulated."

GEI Canada comments dated September 23, 2025:

"Roll Number 4203-580-004-065-030-000 is not within the drainage area of a municipal drain as such we have no further comments regarding this lot."

Conclusion & Recommendation

It has been demonstrated that the proposed application is consistent with the Provincial Planning Statement 2024, complies with the Grey County Official Plan and the general intent and purpose of the Township of Georgian Bluffs Zoning By-law 2020-020. Accordingly, it is recommended that application B19/25 be **approved** with the following conditions applied:

- That a Reference Plan be completed, and a copy filed with the Municipal Clerk or an exemption from the Reference Plan be received from the Land Registry Office.
- 2. That, pursuant to Section 53(42) of the Planning Act, the 'Certificate of Consent' be affixed to the deed within two years of the giving of the Notice of Decision or as specified in the Planning Act at the time of deed stamping.
- That the applicant(s) pays the applicable consent certification fee at the time of certification of the deeds.

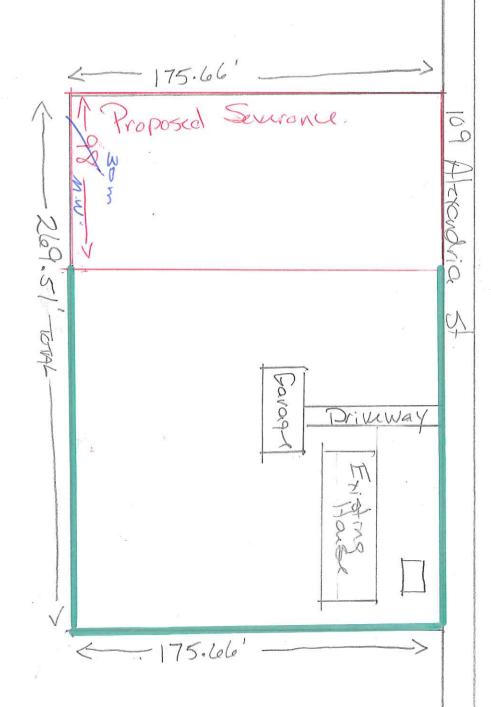

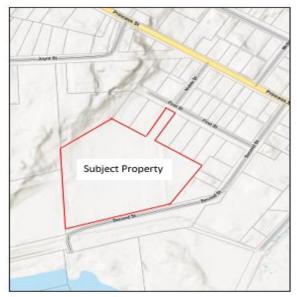


Figure 1: Location Map – 91 Second Street (Outlined in Red)

The purpose of the submitted consent applications is to sever the property municipally addressed as 91 Second Street, within the Township of Georgian Bluffs, to facilitate the creation of three (3) residential parcels intended for future residential use. The remaining 4.14-hectares of retained land are intended to remain vacant for the time being. The proposed Severed Parcels of land will have a lot width of 30 metres on Second Street, a lot depth of 65 metres, and a lot area of 1,950 square metres.

Background:

Through the application review process, Planning staff have assessed the proposal and received formal comments from the County of Grey requesting a deferral. This request is intended to allow sufficient time for the applicant to provide the necessary supporting materials to ensure the proposed development aligns with the principles of orderly, safe, and healthy community development, and the protection of ecological features.

Given the number and nature of conditions identified, and in light of the County of Grey's request to defer a decision on the subject applications, Township Planning Staff are also recommending a deferral. This will provide the applicant and property owner with the opportunity to engage in further discussions with both the County of Grey and the Township of Georgian Bluffs, and to obtain and submit the necessary supporting documentation.

A deferral will also ensure that both County and Township staff have adequate time to conduct a thorough review of the submitted materials. 16. That the applicant complete a Functional Servicing and Traffic Impact Brief to the satisfaction of the Township of Georgian Bluffs.

All costs associated with new infrastructure, upgrades, or studies required as a direct result of this development are to be borne by the developer.

The developer is solely responsible for the full restoration of all public rights-of-way disturbed by construction activities (e.g., for soil testing, utility connections, etc.). This includes, but is not limited to, the complete reconstruction of the road base, asphalt paving, and sidewalks to meet pre-construction conditions and current municipal standards."

Tami Deiter, Resident, comments dated September 29, 2025:

"I am writing to inquire about the proposed severance of three lots off Second Street in Shallow Lake. Specifically, I would appreciate clarification on the following points:

- 1. Road Access:
 - Which road is proposed to provide access to the new lots?
 - Will access be directly from Second Street or Spencer Street (Noble), or is a new laneway or extension planned?
- 2. Infrastructure Upgrades:
 - Are there any planned upgrades to Second Street as part of this development (e.g., road widening, re-paving)?
 - Will snow removal be affected or improved
- 3. Municipal Water Usage:
- Will the new lots be connected to the municipal water system? Additionally, I would like to be notified of any decisions made regarding this proposal, including approvals, conditions, or changes."

Please note that Staff provided the following response on October 1, 2025:

"Road Access:

Access to the newly created lots will be provided via Second Street, within the Township of Georgian Bluffs. Each parcel will be required to obtain an entrance permit from the Township of Georgian Bluffs prior to development. No new roadways or extensions are proposed at this time.

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Infrastructure Upgrades:

Currently, no decisions have been made by the Committee of Adjustment regarding infrastructure upgrades to Second Street, such as road widening, re-paving, or other improvements.

Snow Removal:

There are no anticipated changes to snow removal services at this time. Any impacts or improvements to municipal services resulting from the development will be assessed as part of the Township's standard operational planning.

Municipal Water Servicing:

All three proposed parcels will be required to connect to the Shallow Lake municipal water system.

Notification of Decisions:

We will ensure that you are notified of any decisions related to this proposal, including approvals, conditions, or amendments, as they become available."

Conclusion & Recommendation

Township Planning staff respectfully recommend that the Committee of Adjustment defer making a decision on Variance Applications B16-25, B17-25 and B18-25 at this time, so that the applicant can provide additional information to the County of Grey and the Township of Georgian Bluffs as requested.

This correspondence is in response to the above noted application. We have had an opportunity to review the application in relation to the Provincial Planning Statement (PPS) and the County of Grey Official Plan (OP). We offer the following comments.

Proposal Summary

The purpose of Applications B16/25, B17/25 and B18/25 is to sever three (3) 0.19-hectare parcels of vacant land intended for future residential use. 4.14-hectares of vacant land will be retained.

Documents submitted with the application and reviewed by staff:

- Notice of Public Meeting, dated September 11, 2025

The subject lands (~4.56 ha) are identified as the following in the County Official Plan:

- Schedule A: Land Use Types Secondary Settlement Area
- Appendix A: Constraint Mapping Karst
- Appendix B: Constraint Mapping Significant Woodlands
- Appendix D: Functional Road Classification frontage on First Street (~20m) and Second Street (~208m)

Comments

Chapter 2 of the PPS states that settlement areas shall be the focus of growth and development and that land use patterns within settlement areas should be based on densities and a mix of land uses which efficiently use land and resources, optimize existing and planned infrastructure and public services facilities.

Schedule A of the County OP designates the subject property as Secondary Settlement Area and is located within the village of Shallow Lake. Secondary Settlements Areas have lower density, a limited range of uses and amenities (when compared to Primary Settlement Areas), and have partial or private services. For development on private services, it must be demonstrated that the proposed use can be accommodated with no adverse environmental effects.

Section 3.6(3) of the County's Official Plan states:

- 3) Where partial services exist in a Secondary Settlement Area, development shall only be permitted to allow for the development of vacant and/or underutilized lots, as well as the creation of lots, subject to satisfying the following requirements:
- a) The development is within the reserve sewage system capacity or reserve water system capacity;
- b) Site conditions are suitable for the long-term provision of such services;
- c) The development is within the existing settlement area;
- d) Allow for infilling and minor rounding out of existing development (see Section 8.9.1(10)(c)).
- 1. The County OP and PPS direct growth to settlement areas. These areas are intended to provide limited residential growth and intensification opportunities, such as the development of vacant and/or underutilized lots within previously developed areas. In this regard, opportunities for infilling and rounding out are encouraged. However, it is unclear how the proposal addresses the above noted policies [3.6(3) and 8.9.1(10)(c)] and requirements. Additional comments are provided below.
- 2. Staff understand that partial servicing in the form of municipal water is available in Shallow Lake. The PPS states that where municipal sewage services are not available, planned or feasible, private communal sewage services are the preferred form of servicing for multi-unit/lot development to support protection of the environment and minimize potential risks to human health and safety. Where private communal sewage services are not available, planned or feasible, individual onsite sewage services and individual on-site water services may be used provided that

site conditions are suitable for the long-term provision of such services with no negative impacts. It is unclear how the proposed lots will be serviced. A Servicing Options Study should be provided, per policy 8.9.1(10)(c)], to ensure that the site can be viably accommodated on municipal water and private sewage services and that site conditions are suitable for the long-term provision of such services.

Section 9.12 of the County OP provides guidance and criteria for lot creation, including:

- a) The land division is permitted by the appropriate land use policies of Section 3-8;
- b) The land division is to promote development in an orderly and contiguous manner, and should not conflict with the established development pattern of the area;
- c) The proposed use is compatible with existing and future permitted land uses on adjacent lands;
- d) The servicing requirements of Section 8.9 must be met;
- e) Direct access from a Provincial Highway or a County road may be restricted as outlined in Section 8.3. Where possible, residential lots must not be approved where access from a road would create a traffic hazard because of limited sight lines, curves, or grades;
- f) Evidence that soil and drainage conditions are suitable to permit the proper siting of buildings, that a sufficient and potable water supply exists, and that conditions are suitable for sewage system construction;
- g) The size of any parcel of land created must be appropriate for the proposed use, and in no case, will any parcel be created which does not conform to the minimum provisions of the zoning by-law.
- **3.** Staff request that a Planning Justification Report be submitted in support of the proposal which outlines how the proposal conforms to County OP policies, including Section 9.12, as well as addressing the *Planning Act*, Provincial Planning Statement, and Township zoning provisions.

Section 3.4 of the county OP outlines general policies affecting settlement area land use types and states that:

- 22) Where new residential development is occurring on larger landholdings, it must be demonstrated that short-term development projects do not unduly prejudice the efficient use of the lands for future development purposes. Lot creation occurring on larger landholdings may require the completion of concept plans to demonstrate the efficient development of the remainder of the lands.
- **4.** From a general planning perspective, staff are concerned that the proposal could compromise the future ability to develop the rest of the property. Per policy 3.4 (22),

staff do not generally encourage 'fragmented' development on a larger tract of land within a settlement area. In addition, the current proposal has not provided any additional technical studies to demonstrate the feasibility of development on the subject lands. County staff would encourage the proponents to consider a draft plan of subdivision, which could include a phased approach, to ensure that development can be comprehensively considered. At minimum, staff recommend that a concept plan be provided that considers the future development layout of the property, including future road connections and stormwater management. Any submitted technical reports should also consider the future development potential of the property. It is important that the proponent demonstrate that future development on the retained lands will not be compromised by the creation of three development lots.

Appendix A of the County OP indicates that the subject property falls partially within a mapped Karst Area. Karst topography refers to the erosion, dissolution or fracturing of bedrock. Karst formations have the potential to influence the movement of water on site (including below-ground streams), overall site stability, as well as providing channels for contaminants to enter groundwater supplies.

Section 7.5 states:

In areas mapped as 'Karst Area' on Appendix A, it will be necessary for the proponent of any planning application to provide an assessment of the proposed area of development. Often, this can be accomplished by on-site test holes, however in some circumstances broader landscape features may indicate karst and may indicate the need for further assessment/confirmation. Depending on the site and the scale of the development, an environmental impact study, Hydrogeological or Karst Study, completed by a qualified individual may be required.

5. From the submitted site plan, it is unclear if the proposed lots and building envelopes are outside of the mapped karst area. Nonetheless, given the size and development potential of the site and that potentially 1.5 hectares of the property (or more) could include karst, County staff recommend that a karst assessment be conducted on the site, prior to any development approval. This study shall ensure that the proposed development can be safely constructed on site, with no impacts to site stability, groundwater contamination, etc. If karst is identified on site, the karst assessment may indicate recommended setbacks and/or mitigation measures depending on the type and extent of karst identified. Further comments should be provided by Grey Sauble Conservation Authority. Please see comment 7d) for additional comments in this regard.

6. Further to the above, staff note that Appendix A also indicates that there is a petroleum well located west of the subject lands. Petroleum well locations on Appendix A may not be accurate. As such, it is recommended that proponents refer to the Ontario Oil, Gas, and Salt Resources Library for the most up to date information and specific feature details including estimated accuracy of well locations. Please be advised that per section 5.8.1.1) b of the OP, buildings should not be permitted within 75 metres of an unplugged petroleum well to provide access for maintenance and general safety unless it can be demonstrated that development can safely occur.

Appendix B indicates that that the subject property contains identified Significant Woodlands.

- **7.** County Ecology staff have reviewed the proposal and provided the following comments:
 - a. Natural Heritage The property contains and/or is adjacent to provincially significant wetlands, significant woodlands, significant wildlife habitat, and potential habitat for threatened and/or endangered species. It is staffs understanding that the proposed development will be located within and/or adjacent to the features. Staff recommend deferral of the applications until an EIS is submitted for review by staff.
 - b. Stormwater Management It is staffs' understanding that a concept stormwater management plan is required to address the future use of the retained lands. Staff recommend a concept stormwater management plan is submitted for review by staff for the retained parcel.
 - Source Water Protection It is staffs understanding that the property does not contain protection areas that are subject to policies of the Source Water Protection Act.
 - d. Bedrock Hazards It is staffs understanding that the property may contain potential hazardous karstic bedrock that may be unstable and unable to support development. The collapse of bedrock or the introduction of unconsolidated sediments and deleterious materials into underlying bedrock cavities is a potential hazard in karst landscapes. Building upon karst bedrock features has the potential to damage property and infrastructure and put the health and safety of landowners and residents at risk. As such, a Karst Hazard Study must be completed by a qualified engineer to support your applications and ensure the retained lands have sufficient areas for future development. We recommend the engineering consultant contact this office to determine a Terms of Reference for the study.

8. Staff understand that the Committee of Adjustment granted provisional consent for three lots on the subject lands in 2014. It appears that a number of technical studies were submitted in support of the proposal, including a conceptual stormwater management plan, and environmental impact study, a karst topography assessment, a stage 1 and 2 archaeological assessments, and an on-site sewage system servicing impact assessment. No technical studies or reference to the previous development applications were provided with these new applications. Additional clarification regarding the history of these studies and applications is requested.

Summary

There are several studies that County staff would expect to see to support this development to ensure the orderly development of safe and healthy communities and the protection of ecological features. At minimum, these would include a Karst Assessment, an Environmental Impact Study, and a Functional Servicing Study that addresses water, sewage and stormwater considerations. A Planning Justification Report prepared by a Registered Professional Planner would ensure that the proposal is aligned to the Township Zoning By-Law and County Official Plan, as well as the direction of the PPS and Planning Act. Staff would also require a conceptual site plan for the entirety of the property, at minimum, to ensure that natural heritage considerations, adequate building envelopes, and site circulation can be achieved on the retained parcel. It is important that the proponent demonstrate that future development on the retained lands would not be compromised by the creation of three development lots.

County staff reserve the right to amend the above comments subject to additional review and information regarding the subject property and proposed development.

County staff are open to further discussion regarding the above comments with the applicants and Township staff.

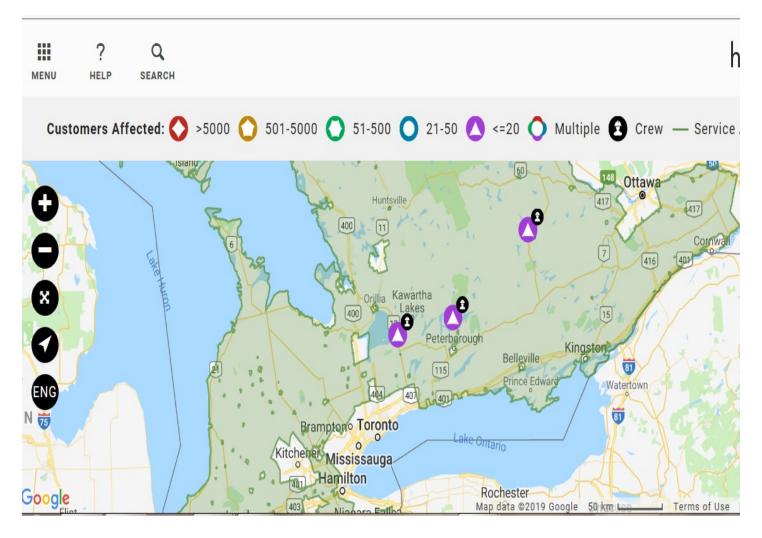
